



# storm water road trip

ALL OF BOWLING GREEN SITS ON TOP OF A KARST LANDSCAPE WHERE WATER RAPIDLY TRAVELS FROM THE SURFACE TO SUBSURFACE



runoff can enter storm water drains along streets



**storm water sewer**

vertical pipes allow runoff to enter underground voids



**injection well**

water may enter natural depressions/holes in the surface and then flow into underground passages



**sinkhole**

passages below ground allow water to quickly travel long distance



**cave**

water that traveled on the surface or underground can collect in rivers and then make its way to our drinking water



**spring**

surface water and water that traveled underground can collect in rivers and then make its way to the drinking water plant
